## Pandemic, Partners, & Progress

Pandemic: "Don't touch. Stay at least 6 feet apart. Don't leave your home unless it is absolutely necessary." We have been told this by the authorities over and over. We respond with questions like, "What does all this mean? How long is this going to last?" The COVID-19 pandemic has impacted all of us. With our office totally shut down, emails from struggling couples continued to find their way to my inbox. As couples spent more time together, what was once a dream now looked like a disaster. With more time to think, we often come face to face with ourselves.

The first week of quarantine was great. I did not have to show up at work, and I had free time to do what I normally did not have time to do. Then, week two was ushered in with discouragement and a loss of perspective. How quickly things change when we do not know the path forward and routines get messed up! Recently, April and I attended the memorial service of Richard Showalter. I was challenged by other's reflections on Richard's hold on Jesus. I was especially encouraged by the following tribute written about Richard:

"No matter how complicated life's demands might seem, each day could be reduced to the simple reality of meeting with and saying 'Yes' to Jesus each day, of trusting implicitly in the Holy Spirit's guidance, and of knowing at the deepest level that he was a beloved son of the Heavenly Father".

Because he knew he was loved, because he had daily communion with Jesus, and because he trusted totally in the Holy Spirit's leading, Richard was able to "live until he died." So, let us take courage. We move forward, choosing not to live in fear. We know that Jesus holds our future, and he has asked us to "live until we die."

Partners: Looking to the future, we acknowledge the past faithfulness of our ministry partners, Duane and Verba Cross. In the later part of 2019, Duane and Verba accepted a full-time position with Jamaican Relief Minis-
