

## Driving Directions

### **Coming from Lansing, Michigan Area:**

Bring I-96 West to Exit 59 (Clarksville) head south 3 miles to Clarksville. Continue south of Clarksville another 3 miles to stop sign. Turn right at stop sign (M-50/Thompson Rd.) for 1 mile to our office on the south side of road. (*See map on page 2*)

### **Coming from Holland/Grand Rapids, Michigan Area:**

From Holland bring I 196 merge onto M-6 East to I-96 then East to exit 52 (Lowell/Charlotte). Get off at exit 52 (First Exit after you get on I-96) (*See map on page 2*) and head south (Right) on M-50. Follow M-50 to our office. M-50 heads south for approx. 6 miles to a flashing stop light and then turns east. The Office is another 6 miles east of the flashing light on south side. Thompson Rd. is the same as M-50. The county name for M-50 is 92cd st. until you get into Ionia County.

### **Coming from Three Rivers, Michigan area:**

U S 131 north to Grand Rapids. Take the M-6 (New Bypass around the south end of Grand Rapids) East (Towards Lansing) to I-96. M-6 ends at I-96 at which point you will want to merge right onto the ramp and head towards Lansing (East). Get off at exit 52 (First Exit after you get on I-96) (*See map on page 2*) and head south (Right) on M-50. Follow M-50 to our office. M-50 heads south for approx. 6 miles to a flashing stop light and then turns east. The Office is another 6 miles east of the flashing light on south side. Thompson Rd. is the same as M-50. The county name for M-50 is 92cd st. until you get into Ionia County.

### **Coming from The Battle Creek, Michigan area:**

I-94 to exit 98(M-66/Battle Creek). Go north approx. 45 minutes to M-50, go west (left) to Lake Odessa. Continue on M-50 west of Lake Odessa approx. 7 miles to our office on the south side of road. (*See map on page 2*)
